INTRO TO A.A. AREA WEBSITES

- What is an Area website?
 - While aa.org provides information for A.A. as a whole, an Area website functions as a more locally specific resource for A.A. information.
 - Similar to inter-group sites, they address the needs of a cluster of groups/districts within a specific geographic area.



KEY ELEMENTS

Ingredients for a useful and functional Area website

KEY ELEMENTS

Well-organized structure:

Information is easy to find and doesn't require too much digging.

Easy to maintain:

Ideally any trusted servant should be able to keep the site up to date and functional without special technical skills.

Is a good resource:

Keep in mind that the site may be a landing page for newcomers, the public, and professionals, in addition to A.A. members & Area Trusted Servants.



2 IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS IN DEVELOPMENT

TRADITIONS

Anonymity:

As the spiritual foundation of all our traditions, have we taken care to redact or password-protect sensitive information?

Non-Affiliation:

Are we unintentionally endorsing an outside entity?

 Think twice before adding links.

Self-Support:

Plan for an appropriate budget to build and maintain the site.

- Hire a professional.
- Draw from local talent pool of A.A. professionals when funds are lacking.

SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLES

Unity:

Ensure that the site is accessible for all.

 Including your local Accessibilities Committee in the testing process can be helpful here.

Rotation:

Build your website with the spirit of rotation in mind.


- Utilize a committee
- Website cannot be anyone's baby

SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLES

More on Rotation:

- Seek out local, dependable talent
 - Technically-inclined A.A. members are a small subset of our fellowship, but they do exist.
- Beware of personal investment when rotation seems difficult
 - Consequences of holding a website hostage
- Make a plan to rotate well
 - Provide orientation, training, tutorials, and log-in info
 - Assist with billing turnover





4 USEFUL TOOLS

OPTIMAL SITE FUNCTION

Primary Purpose:

The ultimate goal of every A.A. website is to make 12th Step work possible.

Technical Mechanics:

Third-party plugins may be necessary to achieve desired functionality.

- This is often applicable to sites built with WordPress.
- Security, forms, calendar, backup tool, accessibility features, media library organization, SEO Tool for specific pages, & analytics

AUDIENCE REACH

SEO Considerations:

- SEO = Search Engine Optimization
- "When anyone, anywhere reaches out for help, I want the hand of A.A. always to be there, and for that I am responsible."
 - Anywhere includes search engine results.
 - We cannot attract newcomers if Alcoholics
 Anonymous is not visible/searchable online.
- Search engines are online tools that index content from websites and provide a list of relevant matches when someone searches for something online.

AUDIENCE REACH

SEO Considerations:

- SEO is an entire professional field that is outside the scope of this presentation, but there are a few key pieces of information worth sharing:
 - Public content should be indexable by search engines.
 - Search engines prefer websites where content is coded and structured in a very specific way.
 - Quality links pointing to your website are an important aspect of SEO.
 - A.A. websites benefit from other official A.A. websites linking to them.
 - Having new content on a regular basis is good for SEO.
